Mission:

Eligibility For Admission

General Eligibility:

- Candidates must meet the eligibility criteria prescribed by AICTE for the academic year 2026-2027. The candidate must have completed a Bachelor's degree from any recognized Indian university (in the regular stream) as per the 10+2+3 or 10+2+4 pattern. The degree must have been awarded by an institution recognized by the University of Kerala.

Minimum Marks Requirement:

- Candidates with a Bachelor's degree (BA, B.Sc., BBA, etc.) should have secured not less than 50% marks (or equivalent grade) in Part III (core plus complementary subjects).
- For candidates with a B.E./B.Tech./BBA/B.Sc. (Agri.) or any other 4/5-year degree, the minimum required marks are 50% in aggregate (no rounding off allowed).

Reservation and Relaxation: SC/ST, SEBC, and differently abled candidates will be provided with a relaxation in eligibility as per the University of Kerala's rules.

Entrance Examination Requirement: Candidates must have a valid score in any of the following entrance examinations: CAT (Common Admission Test), C-MAT (Common Management Admission Test), and K-MAT (Kerala Management Aptitude Test). Admission will be based on scores from the current academic year (2026) as well as the previous academic year.

Selection Process: The provisional rank list for admission will be prepared based on the following criteria:

- Entrance Test Score: 80% weightage
- Group Discussion: 10% weightage
- Interview: 10% weightage

Eligibility Certificate: Candidates who have completed their Bachelor's degree from other universities must submit an Eligibility Certificate issued by the University of Kerala (Course Equivalency Certificate) at the time of admission. Only candidates who provide the eligibility certificate and mark lists at the time of counseling will be considered for admission.
